- ※ All majors are primarily conducted in Korean. For courses offered in English, please inquire with the relevant department.
- ※ Applicants to the Department of Korean Language and Literature must hold at least Level 3 of the TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean), and will undergo an in-person, phone, or video interview.
- ※ Applicants to the Department of English Language and Literature must hold at least Level 4 of the TOPIK.
- ※ Applicants to the Department of Early Childhood Education must hold at least Level 3 of the TOPIK and will be required to attend an interview.
- ※ Applicants to the Department of Early Childhood Education and the Department of Business Administration must contact a prospective academic advisor in advance and are required to submit a Letter of Guarantee for Admission from the advisor (applications without this document will not be accepted).
- ※ Students admitted to the Department of Music based on a supervisor's Letter of Guarantee must complete 9 credits of Korean language liberal arts courses at this university.
- ※ Applicants to the Department of Fine Arts must hold at least Level 4 of the TOPIK, and applicants to the Master's program must have an undergraduate major related to Fine Arts.
- ※ Recruitment for the Department of Fine Arts is limited to Master's programs (Painting, Korean Painting) and Doctoral program (Korean Painting), and all applicants must submit a portfolio.
- ※ The Industry-Academia Cooperative Program follows the recruitment availability and eligibility requirements of each general program unit.

II. Eligibility for Application

■ Common Requirements

Individuals with a certain level of proficiency in Korean or English
(individuals who possess one or more of the qualifications below)

1. Individuals who have achieved a level of 3 or above on the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK).
2. Individuals who have scored 71 or higher on the TOEFL iBT, 600 or higher on the Test of English Proficiency developed by Seoul National University (New TEPS 326), 5.5 or higher on the IELTS, B2 or higher on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR), or 700 or higher on the TOEIC.
3. Applicants who have submitted a pledge of admission from a guiding professor at Changwon National University (for the relevant major).

■ Master's Program

1. Individuals who hold (or are expected to hold) a bachelor's degree from a Korean or foreign university and have both parents who are foreign nationals.
2. Individuals who have completed (or are expected to complete) an educational program equivalent to primary, middle, high school, or university education in Korea while overseas and have obtained (or are expected to obtain) a bachelor's degree.

■ Doctoral Program

1. Individuals who hold (or are expected to hold) a master's degree from a domestic or foreign university and have both parents who are foreign nationals.
2. Individuals who have completed (or are expected to complete) an educational program equivalent to primary, middle, high school, university, or graduate school (master's) education in Korea while overseas and have obtained (or are expected to obtain) a master's degree.

■ Combined Master's and Doctoral Program

1. Individuals who hold (or are expected to hold) a bachelor's degree from a domestic or foreign university and have both parents who are foreign nationals.
2. Individuals who have completed (or are expected to complete) an educational program equivalent to primary, middle, high school, or university education of Korea in overseas and have obtained (or are expected to obtain) a bachelor's degree.
3. Individuals who have been recommended by the guiding professor of the desired major.

■ Academic and Industry Cooperative Program

A person who meets the above-mentioned qualifications and common requirements for each course, and is currently employed at a research institute for the academic-research cooperation course of <KIMM / KERI / KICET / KITECH / KIMS> and has been recommended by the head of the affiliated institution.

- ※ Applicants expected to obtain their degree must do so by August 31, 2026.
- ※ Academic backgrounds obtained through overseas homeschooling, cyber learning, adult education, or qualification exams (e.g., GED) are not recognized.
- ※ Applicants with dual citizenship are not eligible to apply.
- ※ Applicants who hold citizenship in countries where English is the native language (United States, United Kingdom, Canada, South Africa, New Zealand, Australia, and Ireland) may apply without meeting the language proficiency requirement by submitting proof of their highest level of education.

■ Note on Required Documents

1. Applicants must submit all required documents (including those necessary for visa issuance) listed in the application guidelines by May 19, 2026 (Tue). Documents not written in Korean or English must be accompanied by a notarized translation in Korean or English.

- A. Notarized documents must have been issued within one year from the date of application submission.
- B. All submitted documents must be originals. If reissuance of an original document is not possible, a copy must be submitted with a certified true copy verification (original comparison confirmation) from the issuing institution or a notarized copy certified by a notary public (or a notarization office, in the case of China).
- C. Applicants currently enrolled in the Korean Language Institute of Changwon National University may substitute documents previously submitted at the time of admission.

2. Submission of proof of final academic qualification (choose one of the following a–c)

- A. Academic documents (graduation certificate and transcript) with Apostille certification.
- B. Academic documents (graduation certificate and transcript) verified by the Korean consulate in the applicant’s country or by a foreign embassy/consulate in Korea.

- a. Applicants from countries other than China: Submit a birth certificate or a certificate of family relationship (with notarized translation).
- b. In the case of parental divorce or death: Submit a divorce certificate or death certificate, along with a birth certificate (with notarized translation).

4. Applicants expected to obtain a degree must submit a Certificate of Expected Graduation or a Certificate of Enrollment at the time of document submission, and later submit the final degree certificate along with proof of final academic qualification (by August 31, 2026).

- For countries* where issuance of graduation certificates is delayed, applicants whose graduation date falls within one year from the date of issuance of the Standard Admission Letter may submit alternative documents such as a Certificate of Expected Graduation or a Provisional Graduation Certificate. (However, the official graduation certificate must be additionally submitted when extending the period of stay.)**

* Vietnam, Myanmar, Nepal, India, Malaysia, Sri Lanka, Cambodia, Israel, etc.

** This applies to countries other than China, and documents must be authenticated by Apostille or consular confirmation from a Korean diplomatic mission in the issuing country.

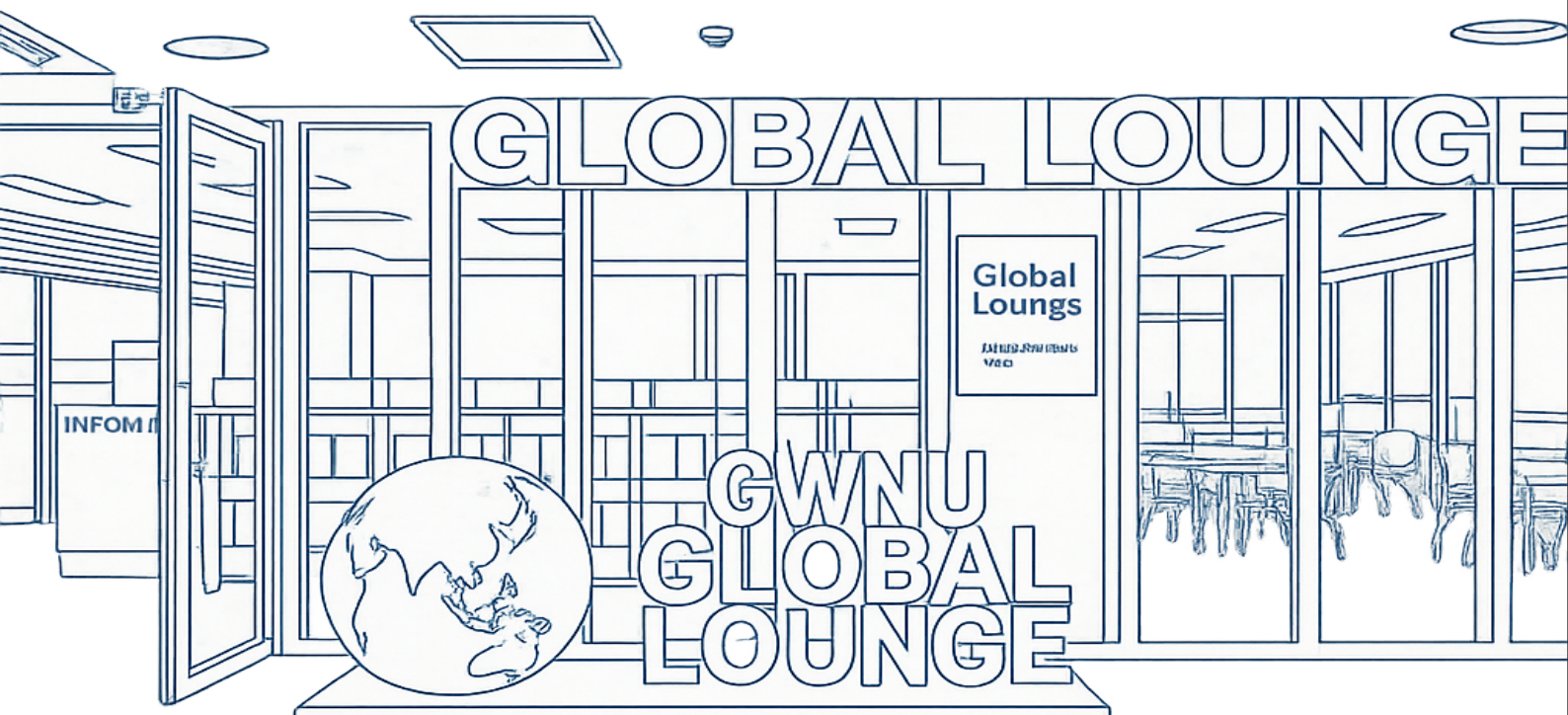
5. Proof of financial capacity : A bank balance certificate showing a deposit of at least KRW 16,000,000 under the name of the sponsor (the applicant or their parent) must be submitted.

- In principle, the certificate must be issued within 30 days from the date of document submission.
- If the bank balance certificate is under a parent's name, a certificate of employment or a business registration certificate, along with a Financial Support Agreement for Study Abroad, must be submitted.
- For scholarship recipients, if the total scholarship amount is less than KRW 16,000,000, additional proof of financial capacity must be submitted.

6. Language test scores are valid for two years and must be within the validity period as of the application deadline (May 15, 2026).

7. Additional documents may be requested if necessary to verify facts related to eligibility and qualifications.

8. Applicants must regularly check their email and the Changwon National University website (<http://www.changwon.ac.kr>) to confirm document submission status and any missing documents



V. Admissions Components and Methods

1. Evaluation Components : Document screening and departmental review (including practical examinations for arts and physical education majors)

- ※ The Departments of Korean Language and Literature, Early Childhood Education, and Music conduct separate oral (interview) examinations.
- ※ The Department of Music also conducts a separate practical examination.

2. Evaluation Method : Comprehensive evaluation based on academic performance from previous programs, proficiency in Korean and English, and the applicant’s study plan.

3. Practical Examination

- ① Practical examinations for arts and physical education majors are determined separately by each department depending on the applicant pool. For details, please contact the respective department.
- ② Applicants to the Department of Fine Arts (Painting, Korean Painting, Sculpture) must submit a portfolio consisting of ten 8×10 inch photographs of their artwork. Each photograph must include a caption (title, size, material, and year) and be compiled in an A4 clear file.
- ③ Plan for the practical examination in the Department of Music: Detailed instructions regarding the examination method and content will be provided separately by each department after the application deadline.

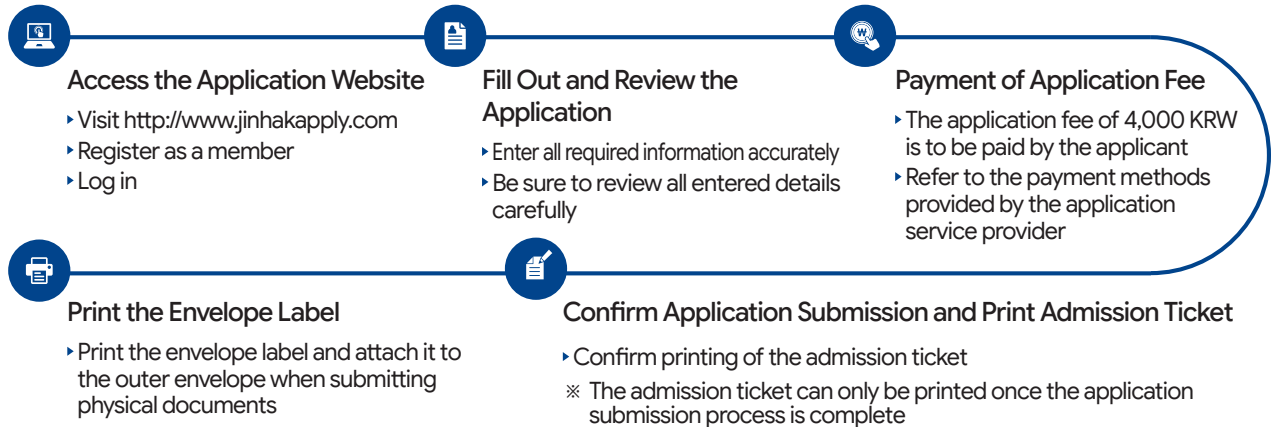

Application Fee

1. Amount : 50,000KRW(All majors)
 - Internet application service fee: 4,000 KRW (paid by applicant)
 - When the admission fee is refunded, the internet application fee will be deducted before refund
2. Payment Method : Payment is made during the application submission process

VII. Applicant Precautions

1. Applicants may not apply to multiple departments within the university or enroll simultaneously in other universities or graduate schools.
2. Once the online application is completed, cancellations or modifications of the application or any changes to the applied department or major are not allowed.
3. The university is not responsible for any disadvantages resulting from errors in the application form or incomplete submission of required documents.
4. If any information provided on the application form or submitted documents is found to be false, or if documents are forged, or if it is discovered that admission was obtained through fraudulent means after enrollment, or if the academic credentials for previous degrees (bachelor's, master's) are found to be invalid, the admission will be revoked. (Applicants must consent to academic verification upon application.)
5. Applicants who fail to submit required documents, fail in minimum qualification criteria, or do not pay the application fee will be disqualified.
6. Application fees and submitted documents are non-refundable.
7. Admission exam results will not be disclosed.
8. Applicants must verify the receipt of their application and documents during the designated confirmation period. Any issues arising from failure to comply are the responsibility of the applicant.

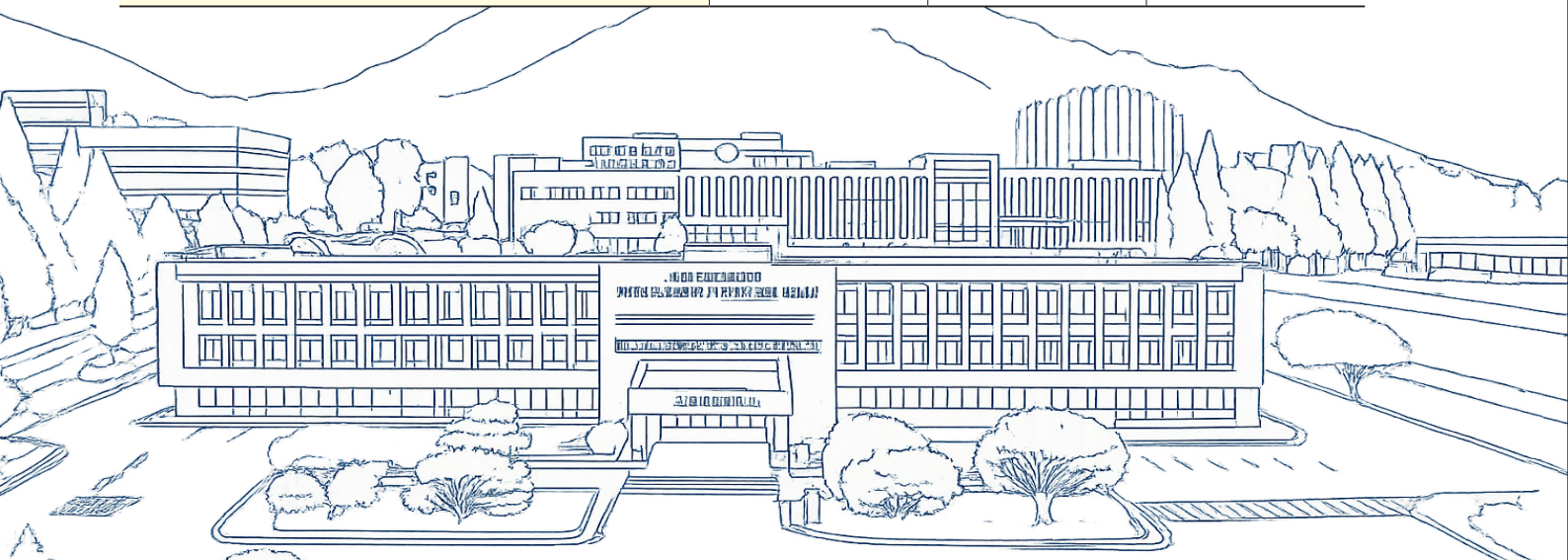
■ Important Notes Regarding Registration

1. Tuition fee invoices can be printed from the university website (www.changwon.ac.kr) and instructions will be provided upon announcement of successful applicants.
2. Successful applicants must pay the tuition fee in cash at the designated bank by the specified deadline.
3. If the successful applicant fails to pay or remit the tuition fee by the designated deadline, the admission will be canceled and the applicant will be considered as having no intention to enroll.
4. If the successful applicant fails to obtain a student visa before the semester start date, the paid tuition fee will be refunded, but the applicant will bear the refund processing fee.
5. Tuition fees are non-refundable after the semester start date except as stipulated by Changwon National University's regulations.

■ Scholarships

1. Entrance Scholarship

- A. Continuing students at Changwon University: Full tuition coverage
- B. Freshmen: Tuition Fee 2 (for those who meet one of the following requirements)
 - Possessing TOPIK level 4 or higher
 - Possessing TOFLE iBT 90 points, TOEIC 850 points, TEPS 700 points, New TEPS 387 points, CEFR C1, IELTS 6.5 or higher

2. Academic Excellence Scholarship

The top 50% of students will receive a differential payment based on 70% of the previous semester's grades and 30% of TOPIK or recognized English language proficiency test scores (TOEIC, TOEFL, TEPS, etc.).

※ Selected within the total scholarship payment range

3. Korean Language Proficiency Scholarship

- A. Possessing TOPIK level 4 : KRW 250,000
- B. Possessing TOPIK level 5 : KRW 350,000
- C. Possessing TOPIK level 6 : KRW 450,000

4. Full-time Graduate Students Scholarship

- A. Full tuition coverage for the period of enrollment (with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher)
- B. Selected according to the recommendation of the advising professor and must submit a thesis within a designated period.
- C. Obligations
 - 1) Master's degree program
 - Publish at least two papers as a first or corresponding author in a Korea Research Foundation-recognized journal (including a proof of acceptance)
 - ※ However, in the field of arts, submitting at least one officially recognized work performance, presentation, or exhibition at the provincial level or larger can replace the requirement.
 - 2) Doctoral degree program
 - Humanities, Social Sciences, and Arts: Publish at least one paper as a first or corresponding author in a Korea Research Foundation-recognized journal (including a proof of acceptance)
 - Natural Sciences and Engineering: Publish at least one paper as a first or corresponding author in an SCI(E) level journal (including a proof of acceptance)
 - ※ However, the standards of Humanities, Social Sciences, and Arts will apply to fields where there are no SCI(E) level academic journals such as clothing studies and architecture studies.

5. 6.25 Korean War Veterans' Descendants Scholarship

- A. Full tuition coverage for the period of enrollment (with a grade point average of 3.5 or higher)
- B. For freshmen who have been admitted to Changwon University through a special admission process for overseas Korean students and confirmed to be descendants of 6.25 Korean War veterans.
- C. If the descendants of 6.25 UN Korean War veterans register at the Korean Language Institute at Changwon University, they will be exempt from tuition fees for four semesters (one year).

※ Foreign student's scholarship selection criteria (number of selected individuals, detailed payment information, etc.) may be subject to change.

※ Full-time graduate students are excluded from academic excellence scholarship selection.

X. Study Abroad Visa

1. Overseas residents must apply for a student visa (D-2) directly at the nearest Korean embassy or consulate.

2. The Standard Admission Letter will be issued only to students who have submitted proof of their final academic qualifications and paid the tuition fee.

XI. Health Insurance for International Students

1. From March 1, 2021, all international students are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance (with monthly payments).
2. Depending on the coverage provided by the National Health Insurance, additional group accident insurance for international students may be implemented.
3. Enrollment in student insurance during the study period is mandatory, and detailed information will be announced later.
4. Students who do not enroll in the mandatory insurance will be restricted from receiving scholarships for the semester and from participating in international student programs.

■ Application for Dormitory(Student Residence)

1. Refer to the dormitory guidelines and select a dormitory type on the Admission Application [Form1].
2. If no specific dormitory type is selected, it will be assumed that the applicant agrees to be assigned a room arbitrarily.

■ Payment and Included Items for Dormitory Fees

1. Dormitory fees are calculated per semester (16 weeks). Applications and payments for the summer and winter vacations must be made separately according to separate schedules.

2. Dormitory fee payment deadline: Fees must be paid within 3 days after arrival in Korea.

※ Payment must be made within the period specified by the student residence. Failure to pay within this period will result in cancellation of dormitory admission.

■ Other Important Notes

1. A health check certificate (including tuberculosis test) must be submitted upon moving into the dormitory.
2. Use of the dormitory during summer and winter vacations requires a separate application and payment of fees.
3. During the restricted period for dormitory occupancy (1 week) at the beginning of summer and winter vacations, students are not allowed to stay in the dormitory.

XIII. Korean Language Center

1. Korean Language Center: Schedule and Courses

- A. Operates four semesters per year, with each semester consisting of 10 weeks of classes, 5 days per week, totaling 200 hours (excluding public holidays).
- B. Classes are offered at beginner, intermediate, and advanced levels based on Korean proficiency, with academic evaluation (may vary depending on operational circumstances).
- C. Offers TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) preparation classes and various programs, including cultural experiences and writing contests.

2. Tuition Discount System for International Students at the Korean Language Center (Based on 2023 Academic Year)

- A. Partial tuition discounts are applied to language programs for international students enrolled at the university.
- B. Discount details: One-third off the Korean language program tuition (KRW 400,000 discount per student).
- C. Program tuition: KRW 800,000 per student (applies to undergraduate, graduate, and exchange students enrolled at the university).
